NOTES FOR PLANNERS

The seven weeks between September's Time of Creation and Christ the King Sunday (November 28) include three lesser festivals/occasions that communities may celebrate in their Sunday worship: Thanksgiving, Reformation, and All Saints. This collection of worship plans includes full orders (Service of the Word and Holy Communion) for each of those days.

Because of the possibility of using alternate lectionary texts on these three Sundays, these orders avoid an interrupted narrative of the Job texts (First Reading) by focusing instead on the Second Reading and the Gospel during this period.

The Thanksgiving (October 7) orders can be adapted for October 14 and 21, and the All Saints Sunday (November 4) orders may be adapted for November 11 and 18 as well.

Pentecost 25 falls on November 11 this year, the 100th anniversary of the end of World War 1. Resources for that day are being posted separately on worship.ca
